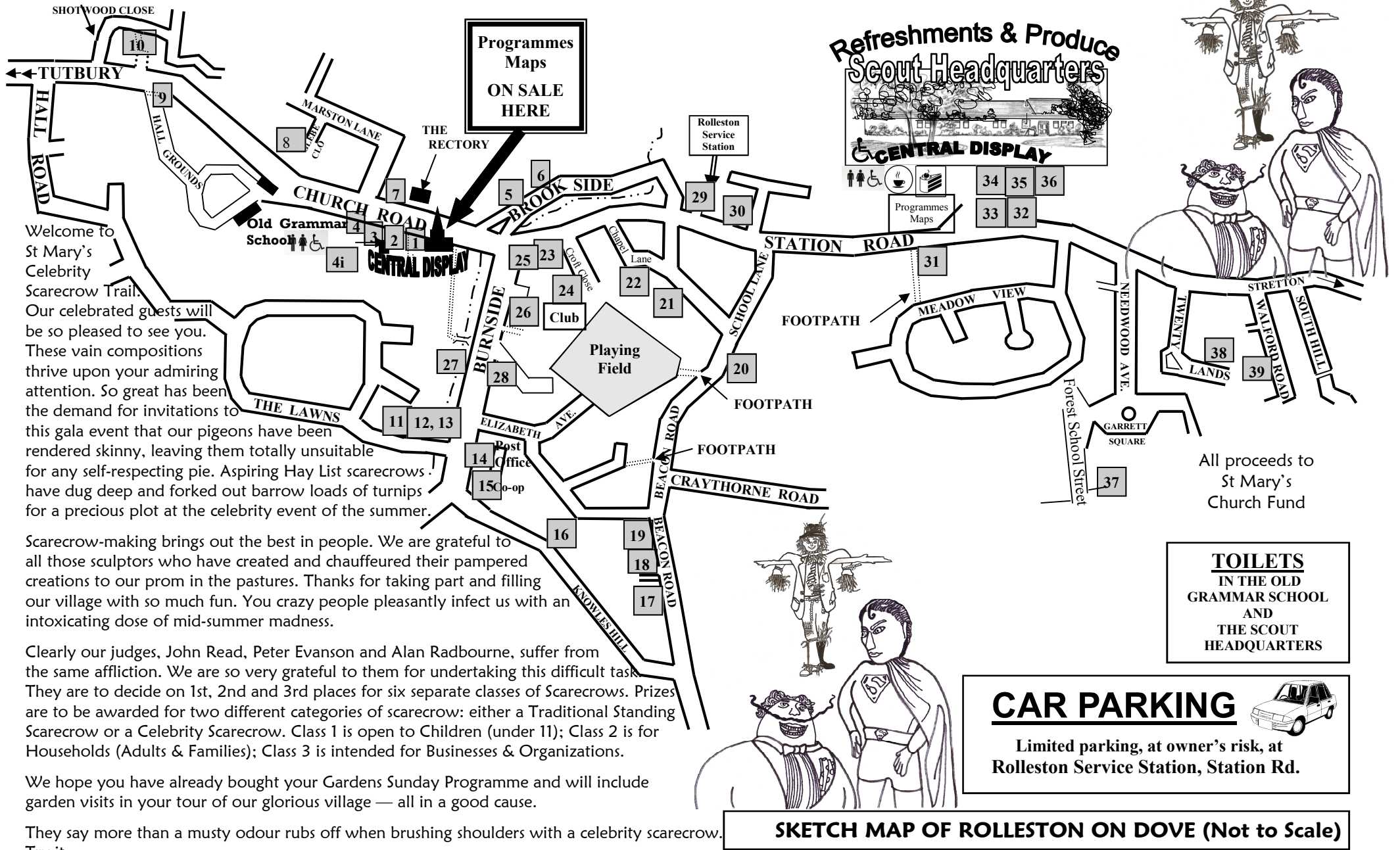


# Celebrity Scarecrow Competition Trail
