<u>BELLWAY HOMES CONSTRUCTIO MANAGEMENT PLAN</u> (College Fields development)

We have now received notification that Bellways have developed their Construction Management Plan for the College Fields site. This includes their hours of operation, deliveries and of course how construction traffic will enter and exit the site along with parking arrangements for residents. As promised at the last public meeting Bellways representatives will attend a meeting with as many of you who wish to attend. The meeting will replace the full Parish Council meeting on 13th August at 730pm.

VILLAGE IMPROVEMENT WORKS

Since the last Rollestonian we can further update you on village improvement works:

Road signs a number of signs have now been replaced which look much smarter and will be easier to clean.

Railings we met with County Council Highways officials who observed with us the damage to the railings along Burnside, and their poor state of repair. They have promised to come back to us with a solution to repair and repaint. We hope to be able to update you on this later in the year.

Community Orchard two 'log' benches have been installed for you to sit and enjoy the surroundings, or to enjoy some of the produce on offer. Our thanks go Nathan Barnett of Barnett Tree Services for not only installing the logs, but for carving them into benches.

Surface water our thanks go to the Blue Cross Equine Centre for completing works to their ditches, and for installing a pond on their land to store surface water and stop it draining from the fields and crossing Dovecliffe Road. This was a danger in colder weather as it froze on the bend causing a real hazard to road users.

Community enforcement officers will be around in the village over the summer to talk to residents about anti-social issues such as dog fouling and litter. 'Pick up after your dog' stencilling will be spray painted in problem areas. They will also visit business owners about keeping areas tidy and incidents of fly tipping.

Replacement tractor following a successful application to the County Council for part funding, we have been able to purchase an old tractor which with the help of our Contractor, Youth Representative and Clay Mills Pumping Station will be transformed into a piece of play equipment for Tafflands Woods. This is to replace the wooden tractor which had deteriorated into disrepair. Look out for pictures on its transformation coming soon.

Replacement spinner It is with regret that we inform you that we were not successful in obtaining funding from the Co-op Community Fund to cover the costs of replacing the spinner on Elizabeth Avenue Park which has been missing now for some time. We will continue to pursue other sources of funding. If anyone has any ideas on where we may be able to get financial assistance, please let us know. The approximate cost of purchase and installation is around £5,000.

NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Thank you to the many who contributed either in writing, or personally with comments and amendments to the NHD over recent months. These will all be considered by the Steering Group. It is unfortunate that the consultation will need to be repeated due to administration technicalities which meant that not all consultees got the full amount of time to comment.

BEACON ROAD SURFACE WORKS

We met with County Council Highways to look at Beacon Road. The County Highways budget this year is no where near as big as they were expecting therefore Beacon Road cannot be resurfaced currently. It is on the list of roads to be resurfaced in the County once funding is found, but in the mean time pot holes will continue to be filled, and the quality of repairs monitored.
