I replied giving information about the Croft, the signage review as per last meeting to be completed by Cllrs Barnfield and Wyatt. I also contacted the enforcement team at ESBC who said there is a prohibitive order on the Croft for dogs to be kept on leads. I have looked at the cost of replacing the current sign and maybe buying another for another location on The Croft – enclosed.

Thankyou letter received from FJORPS for use of Elizabeth Avenue and the donation, although it was a very wet day, they still managed to raise £4500.

Information received from ESBC regarding the memorial bench on Brook Hollows for Mrs Mayer. ESBC will allow the bench to be placed if the PC pays for the upkeep. Please can we have a decision about this?

Quote received from Nathan Barnett (tree surgeon) for works along the Jinnie Trail. The quote is £800 for the trees along the milk/cattle docks and the buffer stop. Councillors had agreed to this work when met with Clive Baker However it was on the proviso of finding further funding for the wall etc. Do Councillors wish to provide this funding for the trees?

Meeting held with ESBC and members of the NHP Steering Group 24<sup>th</sup> June. Papers attached from EBSC with my notes showing what was agreed, plus the expected timetable.

Various Facebook comments have been following a post made regarding the proposed 30mph zone into Tutbury. Lots of comments regarding the speed bumps, speeding through the village generally, the co-op parking again and an idea of 20mph zone through the village.
