Any variety unless otherwise specified.

1. Potatoes - White, 5 on a plate
2. Potatoes - Coloured, 5 on a plate
3. Carrots - 3 with 3" top
4. Parsnips - 2 with 3" top
5. Beetroot - 3 with 3" top
6. Leeks - 3 with roots
7. Onions - 3, each less than 8ozs (*dressed*)
8. Onions - 3, each 8ozs or more (*as grown*)
9. Shallots - 7 on a plate
10. Runner beans - 5
11. French beans - 5
12. Lettuce - 2 with roots
13. Cabbages - 2 with 3" stalk
14. Sweet Corn - 2 with stalks attached
15. Courgettes - 2 approx 6" (*any cultivar*)
16. Marrows - 2 up to and not exceeding 16"
17. Squash - 2
18. Cucumbers - 2 with stalks (*any cultivar*)
19. Tomatoes - medium size, 5 on a plate
20. Tomatoes - small-fruited- a truss of at least 9 ripe fruits, each fruit not to exceed 1½ dia.
21. Peppers sweet - 2 with stalks
22. Chillies - 3 with stalks
23. Collection of 3 different kinds of vegetables - quantities as per schedule

Vegetables- Large

24. Heaviest pumpkin
25. Heaviest marrow
26. Heaviest cabbage
27. Longest runner bean
28. Funniest fruit or vegetable

Fruit

29. Apples- Dessert, 5 on a plate
30. Apples- Cooking, 5 on a plate
31. Pears- 5 on a plate
32. Raspberries- with stalks, any number on a plate
33. Any other Soft Fruit- with stalks, any number on a plate
34. Stoned Fruit- nos. optional on a plate
35. Any other fruit- nos. optional on a plate

Pot Plants

- Single plant in a pot- any size
36. Fruit or vegetable of any kind
 37. Fuchsia
 38. Flowering- not fuchsia or orchid
 39. Foliage

41. Dahlias - 3, under 4"
42. Dahlias - 3, over 4"
43. Chrysanthemums - 3blossoms
44. Chrysanthemums - 3 sprays
45. Roses - a single rose
46. Roses - 3 blossoms
47. Gladioli - 3 stems (*any cultivar*)
48. Annuals - one vase, mixed, any number of stems
49. Perennials - one vase, mixed any number of stems
50. A vase of mixed flowers - minimum of 3 different kinds

52. **"Red with Glitter"**
Arrangement suitable for a Christmas table with red flowers foliage and glitter.
53. **"Calla Lilies"**
Arrangement containing six Calla lilies with foliage.
54. **"Continental"**
Arrangement on a 12" ring base using five different flowers plus foliage.
55. **"Fashion"**
Arrangement of flowers and foliage in a shoe.
