Vegetables - Culinary

*All entries should be grown for domestic use.
Any variety unless otherwise specified.*

1. Potatoes - White, 5 on a plate
2. Potatoes - Coloured, 5 on a plate
3. Carrots - 3 with 3" top
4. Parsnips - 2 with 3" top
5. Beetroot - 3 with 3" top
6. Leeks - 3 with roots
7. Onions - 3, each less than 8ozs (*dressed*)
8. Onions - 3, each 8ozs or more (*as grown*)
9. Shallots - 7 on a plate
10. Runner beans - 5
11. French beans - 5
12. Lettuce - 2 with roots
13. Cabbages - 2 with 3" stalk
14. Sweet Corn - 2 with stalks attached
15. Courgettes - 2 approx 6" (*any cultivar*)
16. Marrows - 2 up to and not exceeding 16"
17. Squash - 2
18. Cucumbers - 2 with stalks (*any cultivar*)
19. Tomatoes - medium size, 5 on a plate
20. Tomatoes - small-fruited - a truss of at least 9 ripe fruits, each fruit not to exceed 1 1/4" dia.
21. Peppers sweet - 2 with stalks
22. Chillies - 3 with stalks
23. Collection of 3 different kinds of vegetables - quantities as per schedule



Children's Horticulture

24. Any vegetable grown by a child up to 12yrs
25. A vase of annual flowers grown by a child any age up to 12yrs

Where the vegetable is listed above it should meet the same specification, e.g. 5 runner beans. Other vegetables should generally be more than one, in the case of e.g. radishes or spring onions, a bunch. These are "grown for eating classes", not for size or peculiarities.

Vegetables – Large

26. Heaviest pumpkin
27. Heaviest marrow
28. Heaviest cabbage
29. Longest runner bean
30. Funniest fruit or vegetable



Fruit

31. Apples - Dessert, 5 on a plate
32. Apples - Cooking, 5 on a plate
33. Pears - 5 on a plate
34. Raspberries - with stalks, any number on a plate
35. Any other Soft Fruit – with stalks, any number on a plate
36. Stoned Fruit – nos. optional on a plate
37. Any other fruit – nos. optional on a plate



Pot Plants

Single plant in a pot - any size

38. Sweet or Chilli Pepper of any kind
39. Fruit or vegetable of any other kind
40. Fuchsia
41. Flowering – not fuchsia or orchid
42. Foliage
43. Cactus/Succulent



Flowers

44. Dahlias - 3, under 4"
45. Dahlias - 3, over 4"
46. Chrysanthemums - 3 blooms
47. Chrysanthemums - 3 sprays
48. Roses - a single rose
49. Roses - 3 blooms
50. Gladioli - 3 stems (*any cultivar*)
51. Annuals - one vase, mixed kinds, any number of stems
52. Perennials - one vase, mixed, any number of stems
53. A vase of mixed flowers - minimum of 3 different kinds

54. "An Arrangement in or on a Box"
Using two colour shades of flowers.
55. "An Arrangement of Foliage & Fruit"
56. "A Foam Ring"
With carnations and foliage.
57. "An Arrangement in a Watering Can"
58. "An Arrangement for Remembrance"

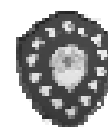
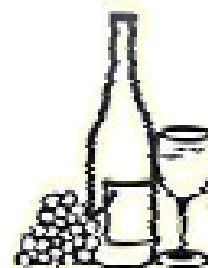
